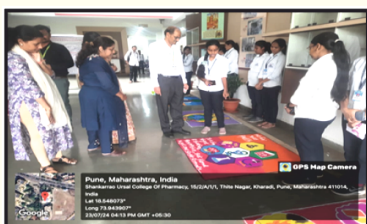
3.4) Blood donation Camp

5) Death Anniversary of Lokmanya Tilak

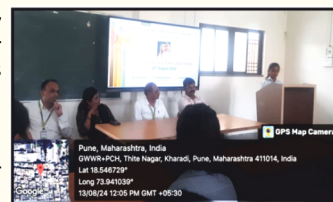
