A.1. Mechanism: PO Attainment





Mechanism of Programme Outcome Attainment

- For each programme outcome (PO) attainment, both direct and indirect tools were taken into consideration.
- The Direct Assessment Parameter takes into account both the results of Internal Exams and End Semester University Examination.
- Indirect Assessment Parameters includes feedback obtained from Employers, Alumni Students, Student Placement, Student participation in extracurricular and Co-curricular activities.
- Based on the learning domain of PO, the weightage for each Direct and Indirect Assessment tool is defined and for each tool four attainment levels were prescribed.
- For each level of attainment, a proper scoring rubric scale is defined.
- Attainment score is determined using the following formula. Attainment Score = Weightage x Level of Attainment/100
- Lastly, the total of the attainment Scores from both the direct and indirect Assessments is used to calculate PO attainment.


