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

**29<sup>th</sup> August 2024**





**Report**

The *Zonal Championship Program and Hands-on Workshop in Artificial Intelligence in Pharma* was organized in association with Makeintern and the Entrepreneurship Cell (E-Cell) of IIT Hyderabad. Spanning five days (13<sup>th</sup> January 2025 – 17<sup>th</sup> January 2025), the event aimed to provide a comprehensive understanding of Artificial Intelligence (AI) applications in the pharmaceutical domain, including theoretical knowledge, hands-on training, and practical demonstrations.

The program commenced with a formal inauguration ceremony. The event began with anchoring and a preamble by Mrs. Trusha P. Shangrapawar, followed by the lighting of the lamp by the esteemed dignitaries. **Workshop Curriculum and Activities**

The program featured an extensive five-day curriculum that integrated interactive lectures, live demonstrations, and hands-on practice, ensuring a blend of theory and practical applications. Participants underwent an assessment on the final day to reinforce their understanding. This five days' workshop underwent as per the curriculum designed and the details of which are as follows

### **Day 1: Getting to Know AI**

- Topics covered: History, basics, and evolution of AI, including modern applications like GPT-based tools.
- Activities: An interactive session with a Q&A format.

### **Day 2: Basics of Statistical Learning and Computer Programming**

- Topics: Central Tendency, Variance, Correlation, Regression, and introductory programming for AI.
- Activities: Practical examples using Excel and demonstrations of basic programming.

### **Day 3: Machine Learning, AI, and Deep Learning**

- Topics: Key differences between Machine Learning, AI, and Deep Learning; techniques like supervised, unsupervised, and reinforcement learning; Natural Language Processing (NLP) and Large Language Models (LLMs).
- Activities: Group discussions, coding workshops in R, and real-world case studies.

### **Day 4: Computational Drug Discovery (CDD)**

- Topics: Protein databases, homology modelling, ligand-based drug design, docking, and using online resources for analysis.
- Activities: Hands-on training with computational tools.

### **Day 5: Machine Learning in Drug Discovery and Clinical Trials**

- Topics: Practical use of ML tools for drug discovery, including case studies and research paper analysis; understanding clinical trials (e.g., controlled and prospective trials).

Activities: Live demonstrations, practical exercises, and role-playing scenarios for clinical trials. The day concluded with a 25-mark test assessing participants' conceptual understanding. The students, Mr. Ritesh Ravan Salunkhe, Ms. Akshada Govind Shinde, Ms. Rushali Sanjay Koli, Ms. Sakshi Harish Wadhav and Ms. Aditi Nanasheeb Pawar performed exemplary in this program and were selected for Zonal Championship at IIT Delhi.

So in the Outcome and impact, the workshop successfully equipped participants with foundational and advanced knowledge of AI in pharmaceutical sciences. 
